Carol & Gary Noyes ftave put togetfter a club drive up tfte coast, from Del Mar to Carlsbad, ending at an ftistoric park for luncft.


To get to tfte star8ng point, exit I-5 at Del Mar Heigftts Rd. and go west. Take tfte 1<sup>st</sup> rigftt into tfte Beacftside Del Mar sftopping center, tften left around Starbucks to park along tfte rear embankment, towards Vons. Plan to arrive by 9:45 am.

Heading out at 10 am, we'll drive tftrougft downtown Del Mar, along tfte beacft and past tfte Fairgrounds. We'll swoop down past Cardiff State Beacft and into Encinitas wftere we'll do a slow driveby very interes8ng dwellings recently named to tfte Na8onal Register of Historic Places.
